ALTO ADIGE



Founded in 1893, Cantina Andriano was Alto Adige's first cooperative. Protected to the west by the dolomite rock and calcareous stone of Mount Gantkofel, the vineyards have benefitted from the erosion of the mountain which has gradually contributed to the fertile calcareous clay soils that so strongly influence the region's wines. The vineyards enjoy sun exposure from early morning to mid afternoon but relatively cool climatic conditions ensure crisp acidity as well as unique complexity and freshness. Crafted with precious attention to terroir, Andriano wines offer pronounced quality, consistent elegance with dependable ageability. **Experience the true greatness of Alto Adige.**

GEWÜRZTRAMINER "Movado"

*WA: **92** "Cantina Andriano's 2016 Alto Adige Gewürztraminer Movado offers intense but also extremely balanced aromas that are graceful, fragrant and profoundly floral. Honeysuckle, acacia flower and star jasmine rise from the bouquet. As they do, they give rise to passion fruit and peach candy."*

GEWÜRZTRAMINER **Juvelo** PASSITO

*W: **94** "The 2011 Alto Adige Gewürztraminer Passito Juvelo (375ml) is one of the best dessert wines to emerge from Northern Italy today. The aromatic intensity hits your senses from all sides, with both vertical and horizontal delivery that is as pointed as it is long-lasting. Dried jasmine, honeysuckle, orange blossom and passion fruit form a solid base of fragrances that come across in powerful waves. This type-A dessert wine can be consumed alone or with dried biscuits. Air-dried fruit gives the wine added complexity."*



LAGREIN ROSÉ

Vinous: "The 2015 Lagrein Rosé is quite pretty. Cranberry, strawberry, mint and orange peel give the wine its fresh, floral aromatics, yet there is good mid-palate depth and persistence, both of which give the wine its lovely balance and inviting personality. This is a strong showing." (AG)

ST. MAGDALENER

85% Schiava (the region's oldest indigenous varietal) and 15% Lagrein grown in sandy soils with porphyritic gravel (igneous rock with larger crystals embedded in a finer mineral ground mass); hand-harvested and vinified by parcel in small temperature-controlled stainless tanks; malolactic fermentation and aging takes place in large oak casks.

*WS on the 2007: **91** "This shows the sweet and smoky character of burning vine clippings, with a precision to the balance of lightly chewy tannins and ripe, juicy acidity. Kirsch, grilled plum, sanguine and espresso notes mix with hints of lavender, marjoram and sage in this elegant, medium- to full-bodied red, lingering on the long finish. Best from 2012 through 2020."*
