The Méndez Family, Proprietor

Founded in 1940 by the Mendez family and one of Galicia's most progressive wineries, Campante is the largest private bodega in Ribiero. The Méndez family has led a well-recognized renaissance in quality for the appellation. The family's vineyards are located on the slopes of the Miño River, inland from Rías Baixas near the provincial capital and ancient Roman mining center of Orense. Treixadura and Loureiro are the primary noble varieties, along with a small amount of Godello. While refreshing and fragrant, Ribeiro is softer in acidity with a more consistently dry finish than the typical Rías Baixas whites produced just west. In 1996, the Méndez family acquired Adegas Morgadío, the pioneering Albariño estate closest to Ribeiro in Rías Baixas.

VIÑA REBORDA

Crisp, freshly aromatic and versatile dry white wine with impressive complexity and persistence. 40% Treixadura, 20% Godello, 20% Torrontes and 20% Palomino.

Tanzer's IWC on the 2008: **88 points** "Light gold. Mineral-accented pear and orange scents are complemented by lemon zest and floral notes. Silky in texture and dry, offering fleshy orchard and citrus flavors along with gentle mineral cut. Finishes with good clarity and spicy persistence."

VIÑA REBORDA MENCIA

100% unoaked Mencia from a young 10-acre estate vineyard on steep, west-facing granite slopes. Reminiscent of Loire Valley reds, this wine displays refreshing acidity and intense berry fruit with a clean, mineral finish.
