The Casoni brothers founded their distillery in 1814 in the town of Finale Emilia, itself situated in the heart of the flatlands outside Modena in northern Italy. Focused on artisan incarnations of traditional and historic regional liqueurs, the brothers quickly gained a passionate following throughout Emilia-Romagna for the quality and character of their aperitifs and amari. After WWII, Enea Casoni rebuilt his family's distillery, passing on the business to his son, Mario, in 1970. It was Mario who developed Casoni's international profile, and 200 years later Casoni continues to bottle liqueurs designed long ago in their family's history, while simultaneously creating new liqueurs and distillates that respect traditions while expanding possibilities and setting new trends.

#### **APERITIVO 1814**

Using their own ancient family recipe, Casoni produces **Aperitivo 1814** as a semisweet infusion of cold-pressed extracts from local botanicals, including bittersweet and aromatic herbs, citrus fruits, and seeds.

*Rich yet refreshing on the palate with strong, bright flavors. Bittersweet with notes of multiple herbs and fruits, balanced and persistent on the finish. Pleasantly moderate alcohol of 15%.*
