Although the Banville and Jones team selects the Dipinti wines, these bottlings are all produced by La Vis, widely considered one of Trentino's finest "cantine sociale." Founded in 1858, the growers have a vast grapegrowing and winemaking history working vineyards from 800 to 2500 feet above sea level. Unlike other Trentino cooperatives, La Vis is highly driven to produce the finest wines possible.

In 1980 La Vis launched the "Progetto di Qualita," embarking on a strenuous and focused program of improvement in order to pursue extreme quality. La Vis' "zonazione" project directs the renowned enological institute San Michele all'Adige to thoroughly evaluate each members' vineyards: soil composition, altitude, prevailing wind, typical precipitation and exposition are then used to determine the best varietals to be planted and the optimum way to cultivate each particular site.

The winery has also wholly renovated their facilities to maximize grape quality and production performance. Further, as part of a concerted, detailed program, La Vis' 1,300 growers now concentrate in tangible ways on elevating grape quality – and the cantina pays for quality, not for quantity.

World-class wines that deftly integrate tradition and technology, these varietal bottlings highlight the unique characteristics of Trentino wines while representing outstanding value.
