Over the course of many centuries, fruit-infused wine-based punches have been quite popular throughout Europe, including present-day Spain, England, Germany and Greece. Derived most likely from 'sangre', Spanish for blood, the very word *sangria* recalls Spain's long history with these wine punches, until recently invariably produced from deep red wines but now also existing in white and sparkling wine incarnations.

Finally, to the joy of paella-lovers everywhere, the celebrated Juan Gil family has created this authentic, deliciously refreshing ruby Sangria. Specializing in old-vine Monastrell, the Gil family has been making wines for four generations, internationally popularizing—and in some cases defining—great viticultural locations of southern Spain.

Sangria is synonymous with España, and there's nothing like Shania Sangria to bring the festive and often boisterous late-night personality of Spain to an evening of paella or favorites fresh off the grill. Natural fruit juices have already been blended into the wine, but pour a bottle into a glass pitcher, throw in some ice and—according to your own preferences—some citrus wedges, maybe some apple slices and grapes, and **¡SALUD!**

And feel free to kick it up a notch with a splash of brandy or Grand Marnier!

This colorful, vivacious Sangria is an enlivening complement to barbecues to luncheons and cocktail parties. Serve chilled or over ice with a fresh fruit or citrus garnish. 7%.

Delicious, imminently refreshing medium-bodied Sangria heady with a rich perfume of fresh dark berries and citrus. Hints of baking spice complement red and black fruit flavors, hints of orange zest, and a crisp, invigorating finish.
